



# 2010 Water Conservation Poster Contest

Theme: **Outdoor Conservation**



**Contest Deadline:** Friday, March 19, 2010

**Eligibility:** Participating schools including home-schools must be located in Rosamond. Entries will be accepted from 3rd through 6th grade students only.

## Rules:

1. All posters must be drawn horizontally (landscape) on 11x14 white poster size paper.
2. Students may use crayon, watercolor, poster paint, markers, and ink. Please do not use materials that may smear, crack, or chip.
3. Students must work on posters individually; collaborated work (a poster created by two or more students) will be disqualified.
4. Although younger students will most likely receive help in planning from parents or teachers, each student shall do as much of the work as possible by him/herself. Entries completed by students in their handwriting and coloring will score better than those designed, drawn and colored by adult assistance.
5. Only original artwork will be accepted. Reproduction of popular cartoon characters or three-dimensional work will not be accepted.
6. Make sure you attach the student entry form with tape to the back of each poster.

## Contest Judging:

Posters will be judged in March. Judging will be based upon the following criteria.

- Conservation message (50 percent)
- Visual effectiveness (30 percent)
- Originality (10 percent) and
- Universal appeal (10 percent)

Contest winners and their teachers will be notified by telephone of the final results. All teachers that participated in the contest will be notified of the final judging results.

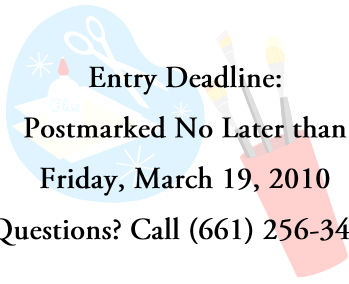

# 2010 Water Conservation Poster Contest Entry Form

## Guidelines

First talk to your students about where our water comes from, our limited supply, why it is important to conserve water, and simple ways we can use water wisely. Then, encourage your students to draw a poster that illustrates one important point based on this year's theme, "*Outdoor Conservation!*" Students are encouraged to use few words, large lettering, heavy lines and strong colors.

## Rules

1. Participating schools must be located within Rosamond. Entries will be accepted from teachers only.
2. Cut white poster paper size to fit 11"x14". All posters must be drawn horizontally (landscape) on 11"x14" white poster paper.
3. Students may use crayon, watercolor, poster paint, markers and Ink. Please do not use materials that may smear, crack or chip.
4. Students must work on posters independently. Collaborated work (a poster created by 2 or more students) will be disqualified.
5. Only original artwork will be accepted. Computer generated drawings will not be considered. Reproduction of popular cartoon characters or three-dimensional work will be disqualified.
6. Although younger students will most likely receive help in planning from parents or teachers, each student shall do as much of the work as possible by him/herself. Entries completed by students in their handwriting and coloring will score better than those designed, drawn and colored by adult assistance.
